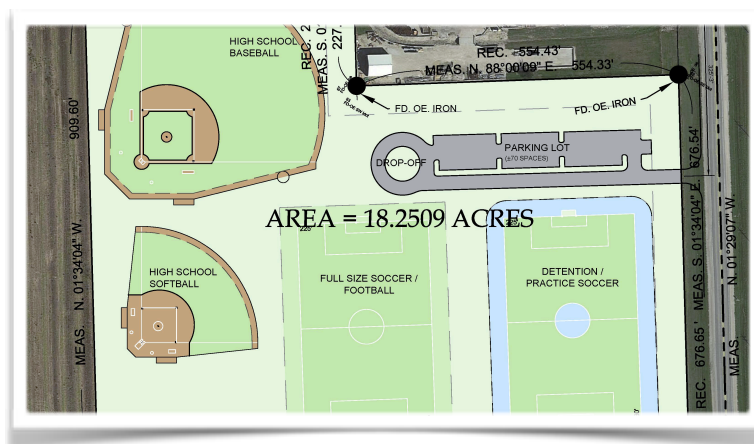
New All Around
