- 4. State Dental Form
- 5. State Vision Form

Returning Students entering the grades below must submit:

- 2nd grade: State Dental Form
- 6th grade: Immunization Records, State Physical Form, State Dental Form
- 9th grade: Immunization Records, State Physical Form

These documents <u>MUST</u> be turned in <u>BEFORE</u> the first day of school. They can be faxed to 630-553-3370, emailed to the records coordinator Mary Ellen West at mwest@parkviewchristian.net or dropped off at <u>the upper campus</u>, 202 E Countryside Pkwy, Yorkville, IL 60560. State forms must be completed and dated within one year prior to the date of entering school. According to state law, Parkview Christian Academy is required to withhold attendance until the immunization requirement is met or a waiver is submitted.

To transfer student records, please fill out the Records Request form included in this email and return it to Mrs. West.
