1. Official Birth Certificate
2. Immunization Records
3. State Physical Form
4. State Dental Form
5. State Vision Form

New Preschool Students must submit:

1. Official Birth Certificate
2. Immunization Records

Returning Students entering the grades below must submit:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> grade: State Dental Form  
6<sup>th</sup> grade: Immunization Records, State Physical Form, State Dental Form  
9<sup>th</sup> grade: Immunization Records, State Physical Form

These documents **MUST** be turned in **BEFORE** the first day of school. They can be emailed to the records coordinator Mary Ellen West at [mwest@parkviewchristian.net](mailto:mwest@parkviewchristian.net) or dropped off at **the lower campus**, 201 W Center St, Yorkville, IL 60560. State forms must be completed and dated within one year prior to the date of entering school. **According to state law, Parkview Christian Academy is required to withhold attendance until the immunization requirement is met or a waiver is submitted.**
