- 2. Immunization Records
- 3. State Physical Form
- 4. State Dental Form
- 5. State Vision Form

<u>Returning</u> Students entering the grades below must submit:

- 2<sup>nd</sup> grade: State Dental Form
- 6<sup>th</sup> grade: Immunization Records, State Physical Form, State Dental Form
- 9<sup>th</sup> grade: Immunization Records, State Physical Form

These documents <u>MUST</u> be turned in <u>BEFORE</u> the first day of school. They can be emailed to the records coordinator Mary Ellen West at mwest@parkviewchristian.net or dropped off at <u>the lower campus</u>, 201 W Center St, Yorkville, IL 60560. State forms must be completed and dated within one year prior to the date of entering school. According to state law, Parkview Christian Academy is required to withhold attendance until the immunization requirement is met or a waiver is submitted.

To transfer student records, please fill out the Records Request form included in this email and return it to Mrs. West.
