## **Responsibilities:**

- Provide weekly academic eligibility plan reports and communicate with administration, faculty, parents, and coaches.
- Adhere to all league and IHSA rules and bylaws as required.
- Serve as the school representative at league functions.
- Develop recommendations regarding the athletic budget, purchasing of equipment and ensuring that programs are cost effective, and funds are managed prudently.
- Provide leadership for athletic booster groups and coordinate, with the coaches, the support group for specific athletic programs.
- Address and respond to parent, student, coach and administration communications and concerns on a timely basis and promote positive community relations.
- Arrange and coordinate athletic recognitions awards nights.
- Responsible for coordinating the use of facilities and equipment regarding athletic programs.
- Responsible for the supervision and operation of all athletic/sport camps.
- Establish, review, enforce and oversee athletic department policies and procedures in conjunction with administration.

- A minimum of a bachelor's degree is required.
- Coaching experience preferred.
- Athletic administration experience preferred.
